Dear Erkki,

Thank you for your message addressed to my colleague Philippe. Wooden poles with a plastic covering may be used at FEI Jumping events. Please note that the FEI Jumping Rules do not regulate the obstacle material to be used at FEI Jumping events but the following weights/dimensions are recommended:

Poles: Diameter: approx. 10 cm
Length: 3.50 m - 4.00 m (outdoor)
3.00 m - 3.50 m (indoor)

Shape of poles: round
flat edge

Planks: 3.50 m - 4.00 m x 20 cm x 4 cm (outdoor)
3.00m - 3.50m x 20 cm x 4 cm (indoor).

Weight: poles: approx. 10 - 15 kilos
planks: approx. 10 - 12 kilos
